Dear Parishioners and friends,

Great to have good news to share and I have a number of positive items to share in this issue. It was encouraging to have well attended services as we celebrated the sacrifice Jesus made for us all and his glorious resurrection. An early morning on Newcastle Beach saw a large crowd singing and praising God for his great victory. A very welcomed breakfast was enjoyed by all, for which we must thank the Power and Carroll families and associates!

I look forward to introducing the Rev. Niall Stratford NSM to our congregations on Sunday14th. Niall will conduct worship one Sunday in every six. The Diocesan Hierarchy is being generous in support of a creaking Rector and have laid down as a condition of Niall coming to us that I take those Sundays completely off duty.


Mothers Union Powerscourt
