

Summer has passed and we are in the season of creationtide, when we give thanks for the wonder of God's creation and for the bounty that he bestows upon us. This harvest season, let us give thanks for the bounty of God's creation but also give thanks for the people who work so hard to harvest it.

It was a great honour to be part of the inaugural Castle Music Festival, which was on from the 13th to the 15th September. Newcastle Church played host to Paul Noonan and Maria Doyle Kennedy. Both concerts were fantastic! All funds raised are for a new playground in the village. A huge thank you to everyone involved.

As I write this we are looking forward to our Harvest Festival services in Newcastle on Friday 27th September at 7.30pm, and in Calary on Sunday 13th October at 3pm. I am very grateful to our guest preachers- in Newcastle the Most Rev. Dr Michael Jackon, Archbishop of Dublin and Bishop of Glendalough, and in Calary, The Revd. Natasha Quinn-Thomas. Sincere thanks also to everyone who decorates our churches so beautifully! There will be refreshments after both services. After the service in Newcastle, the Archbishop will rededicate the Parish Centre, 10 years to the day since it first opened!

On Saturday 28th September, at 1pm, there will be a colour run in aid of St. Francis National School and to support youth activities in the parish. A huge thank you to everyone who has worked so hard to make it happen. It sounds like it's going to be great fun!

The 4th of October is St. Francis' day. St. Francis, and his love and care for animals, is obviously very significant for our school but also features on the beautiful bronze door of Newcastle church! On Sunday 29th September we will have our blessing of the animals service, in Calary at 9.30 am, and in Newcastle Church at 11 am, where we will have a harvest and blessing of the animals service (real and toy!)

Youth groups are back in October, with both junior and senior groups meeting on alternate Fridays from October 4th!

On Wednesday 16th October we are launching a new book club, for young people of secondary school age, from 1st year upwards!

Our Family services will be back at the end of October and we will have a monthly Sunday evening Youth Service returning in November.

Our Junior Choir has been a great success and has brought so much to our Family Services. Russell Smith has been a fantastic teacher, and has helped our young people find their voices, with amazing results! Sadly other work commitments mean that at the moment Russell cannot continue teaching Junior Choir. I would like to thank him for all that he has done. As a result of this, we are actively looking for somebody to continue teaching Junior Choir, building on all the hard work that has been done. If anyone knows of somebody who may be interested, please do let me know.

Building on the wonderful talent shown by our Junior Choir, it is my hope over the next month or so to introduce free music lessons for young people in the parish, with the aim of forming a music group to play at our monthly Youth Service. These lessons will primarily start with guitar and hopefully develop further. Watch this space!

It has been a busy month or so in Calary. There were several concerts in September, alongside newly repaired windows! These concerts were well attended and thoroughly enjoyed! Sincere thanks to Derek, Andrew and Charlotte, and all the visiting musicians, for making Music in Calary such a great success! The John Medlycott memorial concert was held on Friday 13th September. This sold out concert marked the launch of the John Medlycott bursary fund for young musicians. The concert for Culture night on Friday 20th September was also a huge success. October will also be busy! There will be a concert on 19th October in aid of the work done by Sr Mary in Mukuru, Nairobi. Please do join us for an evening of music and fellowship in aid of a very worthy cause. Our Harvest thanksgiving service in Calary is on Sunday 13th October with our guest preacher, Revd. Natasha Quinn-Thomas, followed by refreshments. All are warmly welcome to attend!




